The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release the amount of leave encashment/salary for the remaining earned leaves exceeding 300 days, along with interest @12% per annum from the due date till realization, in terms of the judgment of the the Supreme Court dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) and despite service of legal notice (Annexure P-6 dated 01.09.2024), no action has been taken by the respondent department.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent-State to consider the legal notice dated 01.09.2024 (Annexure P- 6) within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Mayuri Lakhanpal Kalia, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures the Court that the legal notice dated 01.09.2024 (Annexure P- 6) shall be decided by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
5. In view of the above, and without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent-State is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 01.09.2024 (Annexure P- 6), after providing opportunity of hearing to the parties, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
6. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within seven days thereafter.
7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
