**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)**

The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.051 dated 11.04.2017 registered under Sections 307, 337, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana Rural along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 30.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) arrived at, between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 22.01.2025 of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 24.02.2025 to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise arrived at, between them.

3. Report has since been received from learned trial Court, in pursuance of the directions of this Court, wherein, the factum of the compromise arrived at between the parties stands verified and confirmed. As per the report compromise has indeed been effected

between the parties and the same is without any pressure or coercion and out of their free will and the private respondents have also made statement to the effect that they would have no objection if the FIR *qua* the accused-petitioners is quashed.

4. The trial Court has annexed the copies of the statements of the parties, along with its report.

5. In view of the report of the learned trial Court, and the principles laid down by Hon'ble the Apex Court in *Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, and also by the Full Bench of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*, the instant petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all consequential proceedings arising out of it, are quashed.

6. Needless to say the parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements recorded before the Court below.
