**AMARJOT BHATTI, J.(Oral)**

1. Petitioner Palwinder Singh alias Sabu has filed petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 0098 dated 08.08.2023 under Section 363, 366 of IPC (Section 34 of IPC and Section 17 of POCSO Act added later-on) registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Batala.
2. As per the facts of case, complainant 'KK' gave her statement that she is mother of two children. Her son died at the age of 22 years during pandemic Covid-19 on 09.02.2021. Her daughter i.e. victim 'RK' had passed 10+2. On 31.07.2023 at about 03:00 am, there was knock on the door. When her daughter 'RK' opened the door, two young boys made her sit on motorcycle forcibly. On hearing the noise, she came out and by that time those boys had run away on the motorcycle. She had a talk with her relative Mangal Singh. They kept on searching for her daughter. She came



to know that her daughter was taken away by Palwinder Singh alias Sabu and Tarsem Singh alias Golu. With these allegations, present FIR has been registered.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that petitioner has joined investigation in pursuance of order dated 22.05.2025. FIR was lodged due to some misunderstanding. Now matter has been compromised. Copy of affidavits of complainant 'KK' and victim 'RK' are Annexures P-2 and P-3 respectively. At present petitioner has already joined investigation and he is not required for any other purpose.

4. Status report has been filed confirming the facts narrated in FIR. In pursuance of order passed by this Court on dated 22.05.2025, petitioner has joined investigation and factum of compromise is also verified. On the instructions of ASI Sukhdev Singh, No. 2267, Batala, learned counsel representing State of Punjab stated that petitioner is not required for further investigation.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, no purpose would be served by sending petitioner behind the bars. Petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with Investigating Agency. As per status report, some compromise has been arrived at between the parties. Therefore, without expressing my mind on the merits of case, anticipatory bail petition filed by petitioner Palwinder Singh alias Sabu is allowed. He be not arrested. In case of his arrest, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer concerned, subject to condition that petitioner will join investigation as and when required. He will not tamper with or interfere with investigation and will not leave country without prior permission as provided under Section 482(2) of
