2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction be given to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 22.11.2024 (Annexure P-5), by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.
