1. This is a petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for non-compliance of order dated 08.12.2023 passed in CWP-20026 of 2002.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that although all the reliefs as per the order dated 08.12.2023 have been given but the petitioner has not been given selection grade, which was due on 29.11.2004.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the selection grade has not been given since a charge sheet was served on the petitioner on 24.09.2004 and the petitioner was thereafter compulsorily retired on 14.02.2008 which order the petitioner has challenged in CWP-



2440-2008 and although there is stay order in the said proceedings but the said writ petition is still pending.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, the present petition be disposed of at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his rights in the abovesaid writ petition and to raise all the pleas in the said writ petition.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
