1. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite an undertaking (Annexure P-8) becoming furnished before the Appellate Authority, yet the said undertaking being not lawfully considered.

2. If so, for non-consideration of Annexure P-8, but in accordance with law, by the Appellate Authority, this Court, after quashing the impugned order, remands the *lis* to the Appellate Authority, who shall after lawfully bearing in mind the undertaking (Annexure P-8), shall proceed to make such order(s), as may be deemed, fit and appropriate.

3. The decision on the remanded *lis*, be positively made within a period of one month from today, but after hearing all affected persons concerned.

2. Moreover, till a re-decision is made on the remanded *lis*, thereupto, the parties are directed to maintain *status quo* with respect to the disputed premise(s).
