NIDHI GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

1. Appellant-plaintiffs are in second appeal against the judgment and decree dated 09.10.2000, passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Rewari, vide which the appeals filed by respondent-defendants herein were allowed reversing the judgment and decree dated 19.05.199, passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Rewari.

2. The matter pertains to the year 2001 and on the last date of hearing 06.02.2025, notices were ordered to be issued to the appellants. Office report dated 22.08.2025, indicates that the appellant has been duly served.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the appellants submits that despite his best efforts, he has not received any fresh instruction in the matter from his clients. Similar is the submission of learned counsel for respondents that despite their best efforts no fresh instructions have been received from their respective clients. It is further pointed out by learned



counsel for the parties that the dispute in the present case is between the mother-in-law/respondent No. 3 herein and daughter-in-law for recovery of ₹59,000/- on the demise of the husband of plaintiff No. 1/daughter-in-law of respondent No. 3.

4. Heard.

In view of the aforesaid premise, the instant regular second appeal is **dismissed for non-prosecution**, with liberty to the appellants, to move an appropriate application within a period of 06 weeks from today if any cause of action survives in the present appeal. Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to both the parties.
