HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Learned State counsel representing the respondents informs that the petitioner has been given appointment in terms of Writ Court's order vide order dated 09.01.2025.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions further submits that the arrears of salary w.e.f. 01.01.2024 and notional benefits from the date of joining shall be released in favour of the petitioner within four weeks from today.
3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
