These petitions have been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the petitioners for appointment to the posts of PGTs in different subject in their respective categories pursuant to advertisement 18 to 37 of 2024.

2. Learned counsel for the Commission have produced photocopies of two separate composite affidavits, dated 27.02.2025, sworn by Secretary of the Commission in CWP No.29927 of 2024 and CWP No.30045 of 2024, giving case-wise details of marks obtained by each of the petitioner(s) in these petitions, which are taken on record as Annexures 'A' and 'B'. They have also produced result of petitioner in CWP No.799 of 2025 separately, which is also taken on the said case file as Annexure 'A'. These results show, the petitioners herein have secured lesser marks than the cut-off in their respective categories.

3. In view thereof, the claimed relief cannot be granted and the petitions stand dismissed.
