1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners for directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against the private respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 to 18, who in a series of incidents dated 21.06.2025 and 17.07.2025 committed armed attacks upon the petitioners and their family members and causing multiple injuries.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed representations dated 07.07.2025 and 19.07.2025 (Annexures P-4 & P-5) before the respondent No.2-The Senior Superintendent of Police, District Batala. The learned counsel prays for directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the abovementioned representations within a stipulated time.

3. Notice of motion to the respondents No.1 to 3 only.
4. Since advance notice has already been served upon the State, Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, and waives service.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a direction for deciding the representations of the petitioners (Annexures P-4 & P-5) be given to the respondent No.2 and that the instant petition be disposed of accordingly.
6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.-2- to pass a speaking order and decide the representations of the petitioners (Annexures P-4 & P-5) on its own merits, as per law, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
7. It is, however, made clear that no finding with regard to merits of the allegations is being recorded vide instant order, and the police authorities shall be at liberty to take an independent decision with regard to contents of the representation.
