The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 15.07.2025 passed in Criminal Appeal No.113 of 2022 pending before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda, whereby non-bailable warrants were ordered to be issued against her for 04.08.2025 i.e. today.

2. It is argued by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had been regularly appearing before the learned Appellate Court but it was only on account of noting down the next date as 05.08.2025 that she could not appear on the date fixed and due to which the impugned order has been passed. It is, therefore urged that the same is liable to quashed.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record minutely.

4. Though, on going through the impugned order, I do not find any infirmity or illegality in the same as it was on account of non-appearance of the petitioner that an order to ensure her presence in the Court by issuance

of her warrants of arrest has been passed. However, keeping in view the submissions as made in the petition, the same is disposed of with the directions to the petitioner to appear before the learned Appellate Court within a period of two days from today and in that event, she would be treated as on bail.
