SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. This is first petition filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 155 dated 28.04.2024 under Sections 406, 420 IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983, added later on) registered at Police Station Ambala City.
2. The petitioner is alleged with offence of cheating, forgery and breach of trust along with offence punishable under the Immigration Act, 1983, where the allegation is that he took Rs. 12 lacs for sending complainant's daughter abroad.
3. The trial has though commenced, but it is informed that no witness has been examined by the prosecution.
4. The petitioner has criminal antecedents, as he has also another offence of similar nature registered against him.



5. In view of above, it would be advisable that the main prosecution witnesses are examined before the petitioner is released on regular bail.

6. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to re-visit the Court after examination of the complainant.
