1. The petition under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeks the following reliefs:-

- (i) Direction to official respondents to take appropriate action against the private respondents
- (ii) Direction to official respondents to submit investigation report in FIR No.149, dated 05.08.2024, under Sections 304-B, 120-B IPC, Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh, by conducting fair and impartial investigation;
- (iii) Direction to official respondents to decide representation dated 15.05.2025 (Annexure P-5).

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of



Police, Chandigarh, District Chandigarh, to consider and decide representation dated 15.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) moved by petitioner and take necessary action thereupon in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. Mr. Virat Rana, Additional Public Prosecutor, U.T., Chandigarh, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the needful shall be done in due course.

5. Keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, District Chandigarh to decide the aforesaid representation dated 15.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner within a period of two weeks, from today, by passing a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law and take necessary action, if so required.

6. However, if, respondent No.3 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the representation (Annexure P-5), the petitioner shall be duly informed as per mandate of law.

7. Petition stands disposed of.

8. All the miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
