The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.144 dated 26.06.2025 under Sections 108, 351(2) of BNS (Sections 306 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 30.07.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The status report dated 15.09.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 30.07.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 30.07.2025 is made absolute.
