The petition has been filed for quashing of proclamation dated 24.01.2023, Annexure P-13, as also the order dated 29.03.2023, Annexure P-14, whereby Judicial Magistrate First Class, Panchkula has declared the petitioner as proclaimed person in case FIR no.241 dated 09.04.2020, registered under Section 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula.

2. As apparent on record, the petitioner was declared proclaimed person after following due process vide impugned order dated 29.03.2023, and an intimation in this regard was sent to the concerned Station House Officer (SHO) to register an FIR.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ananad Gill, contends that the petitioner has chosen to approach this Court after a delay of more than two years and that too, without any justifiable reason for the delay. He further pointed out that pursuant to the impugned order, FIR no.131 dated 04.05.2023, under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula, was registered against the petitioner, and after completion of investigation, final report/challan was also presented in the Court on 04.08.2025. Thereupon, notice to the accused/petitioner has been issued on 17.11.2025. These facts have not even been mentioned in the petition.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to dispute the facts aforementioned. Besides, there is no challenge to FIR no.131 dated 04.05.2023 or to the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

5. In view thereof, this Court finds no ground to entertain the petition, and it stands dismissed.
