The present petition has been filed *inter alia* praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 111 dated 09.11.2023, under Sections 452, 325, 147, 149, 341, 379A and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sarangpur, Chandigarh.

2. Custody certificate dated 07.02.2025 filed in Court today, is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has a chequered history of being involved in multiple cases and as and when he is granted the concession of bail, he violates the law, however, could not deny the fact that the State did not move any application till date for cancellation of bails granted to him in various other FIRs.

4. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedies as available to him under the law.

5. In light of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

6. The State of U.T. Chandigarh is also at liberty to examine the issue that if a person has been found involved in a criminal case and the F.I.R. is lodged while he was on bail, what remedial measures should be taken.
