The instant contempt petition alleges willful disobedience of order dated 16.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed in CWP-16353-2020 and upheld in LPA-696-2022 on 09.04.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. Concededly, the petitioner was not a party to the aforesaid writ petition and now as per the reply, vide order dated 13.03.2025 (Annexure R-1), the claim of the petitioner stands rejected.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the same, the petitioner does not intend to press the instant petition and shall, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law against the order dated 13.03.2025 (Annexure R-1).

4. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

5. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of. Rule stands discharged.
