1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, challenge is thrown to the order dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-2), which is violative of Section 72(2) of the MV Act, 1988.
2. What propelled the petitioner to file the instant petition, is that the legal notice dated 12.03.2025 (Annexure P-3), which was made to the authority concerned, has not been decided so far.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Teevar Sharma, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents, and waives service.
5. On instructions provide by Mr. Amritpal Singh, Law Officer of the respondents, learned State counsel submits that the legal notice (*supra*) as preferred by the petitioner is under consideration by the respondents, and soon a speaking order would be passed thereupon. He



further submits that within a period of one month from today, a final decision will be taken, and will be communicated to the petitioner.

6. In view of the above undertaking made by the learned counsel for the State before this court, the counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the instant petition, at this stage.

7. **Dismissed as not pressed.**
