SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)**1. Relief sought**

The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked for the second time under Section 482 BNSS for the grant of Anticipatory Bail to petitioners in case FIR No.74, dated 16.05.2025, under Sections 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 190, 191(3), 324(4) and 118(2) of BNS, registered at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

2. Contention**On behalf of the petitioner**

Learned counsel for the petitioners contend that the injuries attributed to the petitioners are not dangerous to life, no specific injury and role has been attributed to the present petitioners for causing injury and on unexplained delay of four days in registration of FIR cannot be overlooked.

Moreover, it is a case of version and cross-version, wherein both the sides suffered grievous injuries and the petitioners are ready and willing to join the investigation and cooperate with the investigation officer concerned, as has been undertaken before this Court by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

On behalf of the State

Mr. J.S. Rattu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, who does not controvert the aforesaid fact with regard to the fact that it is a case of version and cross-version and the injuries attributed to the petitioners are grievous in nature but not dangerous to life. He opposes the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on the ground that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners are required as the weapons used in the commission of offence are yet to be recovered.

4. **Analysis**

Be that as it may, considering the facts that the injuries inflicted upon the complainant and the injured are grievous/simple in nature but not dangerous to life; no specific role or injury has been attributed to the petitioners and the delay of four days in registration of FIR. Furthermore, considering the undertaking given before this Court by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are ready and willing to join the investigation and cooperate with the investigation officer concerned.

5. **Relief**

In the light of above, the petitioners are directed to be released on anticipatory bail subject to their joining investigation with the Investigating

Officer concerned within a period of one week from today, on furnishing of personal/surety bonds to his satisfaction. They shall also abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, which are reproduced below:-

'When the High Court or the Court of Session makes a direction under sub-section (1), it may include such conditions in such directions in the light of the facts of the particular case, as it may think fit, including-

(i) a condition that the person shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

(ii) a condition that the person shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

(iii) a condition that the person shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court;

(iv) such other condition as may be imposed under sub-section (3) of section 480, as if the bail were granted under that section.'

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioners do not comply with the aforesaid direction of joining the investigation within a period of one week, the order passed by this Court today shall automatically stands cancelled.

In the aforesaid terms, the present petition stands allowed.
