

shall be satisfied, at this stage, in case appropriate directions are issued to respondents No.1 and 2 to examine their representations (Annexures P-7 to P-9) and to pass a speaking order thereon. He further contends that they may also be allowed to file an additional representation/highlighting points/issues involved in the present case and the same may also be considered as a part of their representations to the respondents.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Satnampreet Singh Chauhan, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and has no serious objection of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

6. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, respondents No.1 and 2 are directed to look into the various representations dated 26.10.2019, 15.02.2020 and 29.03.2023 (Annexures P-7 to P-9) and to pass a speaking and well-reasoned order on the said representations.

7. The petitioners would be at liberty to file an additional submissions and any other material/instructions in support of their claim to the respondents and while disposing of their representations, the said additional submissions/material/instructions shall also be taken into account by the respondents. The decision taken by the respondents must be conveyed to the petitioners, within a period of four months from today.

7. The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
