1. Present civil revision has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 04.02.2025 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Bathinda in CS No.1396 of 2024 titled as "Ramesh Kumar Bansal etc. Vs. Trust Mander Sri Ram Chander Ji (Registered) etc.", vide which the application dated 15.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioners under Order 1 Rule 10 read with Section 151 CPC for impleading them as defendants No.8 and 9 in the suit has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that since in the impugned order it has been observed that the petitioners are not the necessary parties and their presence is not necessary for the adjudication of the case, thus, he seeks to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to the petitioners to institute appropriate proceeding at the appropriate stage.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
