HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents relies upon an order dated 14.01.2025, to contend that the retiral benefits as regard GPF, GIS, commutation, gratuity and salary for the month of July 2022 have already been released to the petitioner, whereas, the benefit qua leave encashment shall be released to her within a period of 04 weeks from today.
2. In view of the above, learned counsel for petitioner submits that she does not want to press the present petition.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt

petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
