Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari, for setting aside the order dated 26.05.1999 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar.

1.1. A further prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to make good the loss suffered by the petitioner.

2. A perusal of orders sheets reveals that vide order dated 23.10.2024, the following order was passed by this Court:-
