1. This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail under Section 439 of Cr.P.C in case FIR No. 50 dated 29.04.2021 under Section 20 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Uttawar, District Palwal.
2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was found in possession of 119.700 kgs of *Ganja Patti*. However, it has been noticed by this Court that the trial was being delayed on account of non-appearance of the witnesses.
3. This Court, vide order dated 17.12.2024, had released the petitioner on interim bail in the present case, till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of learned Special Court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
4. Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in the Court today and the same is taken on record. It is, however, submitted by him that now the case is now fixed for 12.09.2025 for defence evidence.

5. Since the petitioner has already been granted interim bail by this Court vide order dated 17.12.2024, the said order is hereby **made absolute**.

6. The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court and furnish fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned and on his doing so, he shall be released on regular bail. In case, he fails to appear before the Court concerned, the bail order shall be considered as 'cancelled'. However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the Court concerned on each and every date.
