Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing impugned possession notices dated 17.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) issued by the respondents.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he confines his prayer to the extent that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case his pending reply/representation dated 04.01.2025 (Annexure P-4), which has not been adverted to by respondent No.3, i.e., AAVASD Financers Limited, till date, is decided by it.

3. On the other hand, on advance service of copy of the petition, learned counsel for respondent No.2 – HDFC Bank appears and submits that no relief in the present writ petition has been sought against respondent No.2.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider the pending reply/representation dated 04.01.2025 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate reasoned order, in accordance with law, within a period of 08 weeks, from the date of receipt of copy/ production of this order.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
