SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the prayer clauses (a), (c), (d), (e) and (f), which relate to service matter and to that extent present petition (*CWP-PIL-177-2025*) stands dismissed.

2. As regards prayer clause (b), it is submitted that respondent No. 3, being a civil post holder, who has since retired, had committed various acts of criminal misconduct which are cognizable offences.

3. The petitioner is always free to avail the remedy under the relevant provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure {Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS)} by informing the police authority as regards the commission of cognizable offence, or avail the



statutory remedy available under the BNSS in case police fails to register the offence.

4. With the aforesaid observations, petition (*CWP-PIL-177-2025*) stands disposed of.
