1. The petitioner herein is a defendant in a recovery suit filed by the plaintiff. He sought leave to defend, which was granted subject to furnishing of indemnity bond of Rs.1,20,000/-.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard.
3. The trial Court has only directed the petitioner to give his indemnity bond, which is in the form of an undertaking. A summary suit for recovery has been filed by the plaintiff. The petitioner has only been requested to give his indemnity bond while granting him leave to defend. The suit is based on a negotiable instrument (pronote).
4. Hence, the no ground to interfere is made out.
5. Dismissed.
