1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has competed for one post of Peon/Additional Peon/Chowkidar in the ESP General Category but she has not been selected by the authority concerned, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the applications dated 12.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) & 14.04.2025 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.
3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the case file with his able assistance.
4. Keeping in view the fact that the only prayer of the petitioner is for deciding the applications dated 12.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) & 14.04.2025

(Annexure P-6), the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2 that in case, applications dated 12.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) & 14.04.2025 (Annexure P-6) have been received by the respondent No. 2 and the same are still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the respondent No. 2 by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of **eight weeks** from the date of the receipt of copy of this order. In case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed which order will be conveyed to the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

5. The present petition is disposed of in above terms.
6. Pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of.
