

proceedings in the second suit i.e. Civil Suit No.121 of 2018 (now C.S. No.914 of 2018). The said prayer was declined by the learned trial Court vide its order dated 08.05.2018, hence the present revision petition.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the paper book.

5. As per the records, the first Civil Suit bearing No.882 of 2018 instituted on 27.04.2018 titled as “Sham Lal Vs. Maha Singh and Others” has been dismissed on merits by the trial Court vide decision dated 25.02.2025 and thus, at this stage, once the first suit stands adjudicated upon, no cause survives in the application filed on behalf of the petitioner having invoked Section 10 read with Section 151 CPC, 1908 for staying the proceedings in second Civil suit i.e. Civil Suit No.121 of 2018 (now. C.S. No.914 of 2018) titled as “*Maha Singh Vs. Sham Lal and Anr.*”

6. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move appropriate application in case Civil Appeal No.109/2025 titled as Sham Lal Vs. Maha Singh and Ors. preferred at the instance of petitioner assailing the judgment and decree dated 25.02.2025 is accepted.
