1. The instant petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87 dated 29.06.2025, registered under Section 105 of Bharatiya Nayaya Sanhita, 2023, at Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required in this case.

3. Learned State counsel has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and, on instructions from ASI
