The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in case FIR No.227 dated 10.11.2024 under Sections 115(2), 118,351(2),191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023 (offence under Sections 109,118(2) BNS added later on) registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 26.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Mr. Simranjit Singh, Advocate appears and filed his Vakalatnama on behalf of the complainant in the Court today and the same is taken on record.
4. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 26.03.2025 is **made absolute**. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
