**HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)**

1. Learned State counsel submits that in case the petitioner appear before the Treasury Officer, Gohana on 27.02.2025 to submit her life identification/certificate, the remaining benefits shall be released in her favour within one week thereafter.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
