This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 8.8.2016 passed in CWP No. 21633 of 2011.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"In view of what has been discussed above, the present writ petition is allowed. The impugned order dated 18.8.2011 (Annexure P-11) is quashed. The respondents are directed to step up the pay of the petitioners equal to their juniors and release all the consequential benefits to the petitioners within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this judgment."

Reply by way of affidavit of Harcharan Singh, District Education Officer (Secondary Education), Nawanshahar on behalf of respondent No.3 has been filed. It has been stated in the reply that needful has been done and consequential benefits have been released.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is not in a position to contradict the said position, due to lack of instructions.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, in case some grievance survives, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
