1. Prayer made in the present petition is for quashing the orders dated 27.02.2018 and 08.06.2018, Annexures P-1 and P-3, it being the suspension order and the charge-sheet.
2. Learned counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has been exonerated in the inquiry that was conducted pursuant to the impugned charge-sheet and as such, the prayer with regard to the same has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned State counsel, on the other hand, states that claim of grant of benefit of ACP has been allowed, as stated in para 6 of the reply filed by way of short affidavit of the District Education Officer (EE), Hoshiarpur, dated 11.07.2019, and the GPF account is also being properly

maintained upto date, which has not been controverted by filing any replication. Insofar as the TA/DA is concerned, the petitioner is stated to have not applied for the same.

4. In view of the above, learned counsel submits that the petitioner shall represent the respondents with regard to the aforesaid claim of TA/DA, and in case, any other claim that subsists.

5. Disposed of accordingly.
