As agreed, as per statements of the appellant, his counsel, learned counsel and representative of the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹4,60,000/- (₹ Four Lakh Sixty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

It has been stated by learned counsel for the appellant that in the Bank account and other documents i.e. PAN Card and Identity Card of the appellant, the spelling of his name is Surmukh Singh, whereas in the Memo of Parties, the spelling of his name is mentioned as Sarmukh Singh and that hence, cheque be issued in the name of "Surmukh Singh". He has also placed on record copies of Bank account, PAN Card and Identity Card of the appellant.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹4,60,000/- in the name of the appellant - Surmukh Singh son of Hardial Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 03.07.2025, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount

The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company.
