**2. CRM-M-59015-2024 (O&M)**

The instant petition has originally been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No. 147 dated 28.07.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452 and 34 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Dharmkot, District Moga along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including order dated 02.12.2023 (Annexure P-3), whereby petitioners No. 2 and 3 had been declared as proclaimed offenders, on the basis of the compromise arrived at between the parties. However, vide order dated 02.12.2024, learned counsel for the petitioners had withdrawn this petition qua petitioner No. 1 and had

restricted their prayer only to the extent of quashing of order dated 02.12.2023, whereby petitioners No. 2 and 3 had been declared as proclaimed offenders in the aforesaid proceedings.

3. After advancing arguments at length, learned counsel for the petitioners could not point out any lacuna in the impugned order. However, he has submitted that since a compromise has been effected between the parties and the petitioners are ready to join the Court proceedings, they may be directed to surrender before the learned trial Court.

4. Keeping in view the limited prayer made by the petitioners and also considering the fact that the matter stands amicably settled between the parties and the petitioners are ready to join the Court proceedings, the present petition is disposed of. Petitioners No. 2 and 3 are directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of 08 weeks from today and on doing so, the learned trial Court shall release them on bail, subject to their furnishing fresh personal/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

5. Till the appearance of the petitioners before the learned trial Court, their arrest shall remain stayed.

6. It is made clear that in case the petitioners fail to appear before the learned trial Court within the stipulated time, this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
