1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 01.04.2022, under Section 66D of Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008, Sections 34 & 420 of IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and file an appropriate bail application there. He further prays that the trial Court may be directed to dispose of said bail application in a time bound manner.

3. Allowed as prayed for.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and files an appropriate application for bail within seven days from today, the Court concerned would decide the same expeditiously within a period of one week from the date of its filing in accordance with law.
