Initially CRM-M-20800-2024 was filed by the co-accused seeking quashing of FIR No.22 dated 17.02.2024 under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, 1860 and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulations) Act, 2014 P.S. Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of a compromise dated 19.04.2024. On 03.03.2025, the FIR was quashed qua the said accused. Now the instant petition on behalf of only one of the accused has come up for hearing as he was at that time in Malaysia. A report has been submitted by JMIC, 1st Class, Gidderbaha as per which a genuine compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

In view of the above, the FIR No.22 dated 17.02.2024 under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, 1860 and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulations) Act, 2014 Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom stands quashed qua the petitioner.
