



of the petitioners may be considered in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.9175 of 2000 (Annexure P-4), in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and has no serious objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, at this stage.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, at this stage, respondent No.2 is directed to examine the claim of the petitioners as raised in the instant writ petition in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.9175 of 2000 titled as **“Daljit Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab” (Annexure P-4)** and to take a decision within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking and well reasoned order. In case, the petitioners are found entitled to any consequential relief, the same shall also be released to them forthwith along with a reasonable rate of interest.

7. The present petition is disposed of, accordingly.
