1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner served upto 31.03.2010 but he was not granted the benefit of 14 years ACP in the Cadre of Sub Divisional Engineer though, he had completed the requisite period for entitlement of said benefit prior to his retirement on 31.03.2010.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that though, the petitioner was actually promoted as Sub Divisional Officer on 14.03.1996 but he was granted the retrospective promotion from the year 1994 and benefit of 14 years ACP in the Cadre of Sub Divisional Engineer was already granted to him prior to the retirement in the year 2008 and all the consequential benefits have already been granted.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to rebut the same.



4. Keeping in view the above, as the benefit claimed has already been released in favour of the petitioner, no ground is made out for passing any other order. However, in case, it is found that the statement of the learned State counsel is incorrect, the petitioner can revive the present petition by filing appropriate application.

5. Disposed of.

6. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
