Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 08.8.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-18902-2024 titled as “Malkit Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others”, vide which direction was issued to respondent No.1 herein “*....to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 14.4.2024 (Annexure P-9) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioners are found entitled, necessary benefits be released within a period of three weeks thereafter.*”



Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from Mr. Saurabh Ahlawat, Executive Engineer, Yamuna Nagar submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order dated 29.10.2024 by respondent No.1; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid order dated 29.10.2024 produced by the learned counsel for the respondents-State is taken on record. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Rule stands discharged.
