1. The present appeal has been preferred by the State of Punjab against judgment of acquittal dated 16.12.2019 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, whereby accused-respondent Kulwinder Singh was acquitted of the charges framed against him.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the respondent-accused has apprised this Court that the respondent-accused entered into compromise with complainant Gurwinder Singh vide affidavit dated 05.01.2023, in view of which, leave to appeal (CRM-A-226-2020) filed by the complainant Gurwinder Singh against judgment dated 16.12.2019 was also withdrawn by him.



3. Learned State counsel does not raise any serious objection to the upholding of acquittal of the respondent-accused, keeping in view the fact that the matter stands amicably resolved between the parties.

4. In view of the above, the instant appeal stands dismissed.
