**JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (Oral)**

The prayer in the present petition under Section 483 of the BNSS is for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.95 dated 19.07.2024 under Sections 109/115/118(1)/127(2)/333/3(5) BNS registered at Police Station Kotwali Nabha.

2. The present FIR came to be registered at the instance of Manpreet Kaur and reads as under:-

*"Statement of Manpreet Kaur d/o Hakam Singh r/o 40 No.Gate, Gobind Nagar, Nabha aged about 34 years Mobile No.62803-81627. It is stated that I am r/o above address. I run a salon by the name Sehaj HD Beauty Studio on Thuhi Road, Nabha. Other girls also work at my shop. Today on 19/07/2024 like other days I was opening my shop at 9 am. I went inside the shop after opening it. No other girl was present by then. I was alone in the shop and after 5 minutes of opening the shop Jaspreet Singh @ Whiskey s/o Ranjit Singh r/o Gurdev Kaur Colony, Grain Market Road, Nabha came outside the shop on his Bullet Motorcycle No.PB-11-DB-2427. He entered the shop*

*quickly and pulled the shutter down from inside. I had got married to Jaspreet Singh @ Whiskey around 6 years ago. Now we are living separately. We had entered into Panchayati Compromise to live separately and a case for living separately is pending before Id. Court at Nabha. Which is yet to be decided We are living separately for the last about 3 years. Today he came inside the shop and pulled out Kirch from his back pocket and gave first blow with Kirch on left side of stomach and second blow on left rib. I tried to stop him but in vain and kept giving Kirch blows constantly. Then he attacked on right side of chest and on neck and on left side of below the neck. I kept shouting but nobody could hear my voice because the shutter of the shop was down. I was covered with blood due to Kirch blows. Then he wiped the blood inside the shop and took me out in unconscious condition. He made me sit in unconscious condition the middle on his motorcycle Bullet after covering my wounds with cloth and with the help of his friend Twinkle r/o Kachey Ghar, Bouran Gate, Nabha who was standing outside the shop. They ran away after dropping me off at Emergency, Rajindra Hospital, Patiala for treatment. Then I called my brother Basant Singh to take my care. Now I am at Bed No.13, Ward No.21 (ENT) Rajindra Hospital for treatment. Therefore, legal action shall be taken against them. I have got my statement recorded in the presence of my brother Basant Singh. Read over as correct. Sd/-Manpreet Kaur.*

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case as the complainant is his ex-wife. The couple has a 06 years old child who is in the custody of the petitioner. As he is in custody since 21.07.2024, he is entitled to the concession of bail.

4. The learned counsel for the State and the learned counsel for the complainant, on the other hand, while referring to the reply dated



25.07.2025 contend that the petitioner caused multiple stab wounds on the person of the complainant. As per the MLR, the complainant has received 07 injuries, 04 of which are by a sharp-edged weapon and 03 by blunt force. On being arrested, the weapon of offence has been recovered at his instance. The nature of the allegations and the injuries caused do not entitle the petitioner to the grant of bail.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. As per the medico legal report of the complainant, she has received as many as 07 injuries, 04 of them with a sharp-edged weapon. Injury No.2 has been declared as 'grievous in nature' showing a fracture of left 11<sup>th</sup> rib. The weapon of offence has been recovered at the instance of the petitioner. The nature of allegations and the manner in which the complainant has been brutally assaulted does not entitle the petitioner to the grant of bail.

7. Therefore, the instant petition stands dismissed.

8. However, the Trial Court is directed to conclude the Trial as expeditiously as possible but in any case not later than 06 months from the next date fixed before it.

9. The pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
