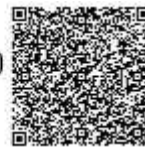

1. Petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 10.07.2024 as passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sonipat in case arising out of FIR No.431, dated 21.12.2016, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonipat, District Sonipat, whereby her bail was cancelled and bonds were forfeited to the State and further challenge is to the subsequent orders whereby fresh warrants of arrest have been issued and presently proclamation proceedings have been ordered to be initiated.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that her absence on 10.07.2024 was not intentional. She had been regularly appearing before the trial Court. Only on 10.07.2024, she could not appear due to some miscommunication between her and her counsel. She is ready to appear before learned trial Court, join proceedings and abide by the terms and conditions to be imposed upon her.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Apoorv Garg, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice and submits that proclamation proceedings have been initiated against the petitioner. Therefore, the petition does not deserve to be allowed.

5. I have heard rival submissions as made by learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. Though, the explanation as given by the petitioner appears to be not justifiable and no infirmity or illegality can be noticed in the orders passed by the trial Court as it is on account of her non-appearance that the impugned orders had been passed, however, keeping in view the fact that she is ready to join proceedings before the trial Court, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 18.08.2025 and on her doing so, she shall be admitted to bail on her furnishing fresh personal as well as surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be paid with the DLSA, Sonapat.

7. Disposed of.
