SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J.(Oral)

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents not to harass the petitioners.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that a speaking order has already been passed in the complaint dated 09.06.2025 (Annexure P-3) by the authorities concerned and has produced the copy of the same, which is taken on record. He has furnished a copy of the order to counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the speaking order is reproduced below :-

'Amandeep Singh (husband) further recorded that now he has no connection, concern and relation left with petitioner No.1 Sarabjit Kaur and she is now free to live as per her own free wish, and he is not keeping any grudges against Saranjit Kaur (petitioner No.1). Similarly, in their respective statements Sevak Singh son of Saudagar Singh aged about 70 years-Cell Phone No.98157-55246 (Respondent No.5-uncle in law of petitioner No.1), Sukhmandir Singh son of Sher Singh, aged about 62 years, contact No.82889-88921 (Father of petitioner No.1) have also corroborated the abovementioned version of Amandeep Singh (Respondent No.4). However, both the petitioners could not be contacted beside putt in efforts and were not found present at the given address.

4. That during the investigation the facts and circumstances of the matter substantiated no immediate threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners.'

In light of the above, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press this petition further.

The petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch), in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.

Petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
