**ANIL KSHETARPAL, J (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner, herein, is the plaintiff. His suit for decree of permanent injunction and declaration directing the respondents to allow him to operate the bank account and for grant of damages is pending. Defendant Ranjit Singh has filed counter claim seeking declaration that he is a partner of the partnership firm with a consequential relief of declaration that the resolution being a new partnership deed is null and void. Petitioner filed application for rejection of the counter claim on the ground that the suit is not maintainable as the partnership deed is not registered. The Court has observed that such issue can be examined when the parties are permitted to lead evidence.

2. This Court does not find any good ground to interfere except the maintainability of counter claim, which is equivalent to the plaint and is required to be examined on the basis of assertions made in the plaint and note on the basis of objections taken by the defendant.

3. Dismissed.
