1. Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.78, dated 14.07.2024, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148 & 149 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural).
2. Vide order dated 28.11.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 28.11.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.



4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jugal Kishore, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, interim order dated 28.11.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
