Short reply by way of affidavit of Haridutt Sharma, Superintending Engineer, HUDA Circle, Hisar has been filed in the Court and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that necessary compliance of the order dated 04.05.2015 has been made and the petitioners have been regularized w.e.f. 01.04.1993 instead of 01.02.1996 subject to the decision of review/appeal and they have also been held entitled for all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Dalbir Singh Nair, Executive Engineer, HUDA, submits that consequential benefits will be released within a period of 10 days.

Since compliance of the order has been made and consequential benefits are stated to be released within 10 days, nothing survives in the contempt petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

Respondents are directed to release consequential benefits within a period of 10 days.

In case consequential benefits are not released, petitioners are at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
