1. The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioners seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the Over Time Allowance admissible to them from 01.04.2013 to 31.12.2016 on the basis of the decision of this Court dated 01.04.2013 passed in CWP-22516-2012 along with other connected matters (Annexure P-2) and further upheld by the Hon'ble Apex Court vide judgment dated 31.01.2017 passed in Civil Appeal No.(s) 7391-7395-2013 (Annexure P-3).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this juncture, the petitioners would be satisfied in case the respondent-Authorities are directed to look into the legal notice dated 06.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) and the grievance espoused by the petitioners



therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Praveen Chander Goyal, Addl. AG Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5. Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.2- the Director General, Department of Transport, Government of Haryana, is directed to take note of the legal notice dated 06.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) sent by the petitioners and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioners is established as per law, the payment due to the petitioners shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of four months.
