This is a petition under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The agreement which contains an arbitration clause is admitted. The petitioner had invoked the arbitration. The respondent, however, did not nominate an arbitrator. The respondent has, therefore, forfeited its right to nominate an arbitrator.

3. The petition is disposed of by referring the disputes and differences to the sole arbitration of Mr. Justice Rajive Bhalla, a former Judge of this Court.

4. It is agreed that the venue of arbitration shall be the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre.
